
JANUARY HOME STARTS DECREASE IN THE ST. CATHARINES-NIAGARA CMA

TORONTO, FEBRUARY 9, 2009 – Preliminary housing starts data for January 2009 released today by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) for the St. Catharines-Niagara Census Metropolitan Area¹ (CMA) report a decline from the same month last year to 65 units.

In January 2009, construction began on 21 single-detached homes while starts of townhouses were relatively strong, increasing to 42 units. While overall starts moderated, home construction was higher in Welland, Lincoln and Niagara-on-the-Lake.

"January is traditionally a slow month for housing construction. This year a slowing economy has weighed on home starts activity." said Ashot Karapetyan, Market Analyst with CMHC. "The downward trend in new home construction activity is in line with CMHC's current forecast for St. Catharines-Niagara."
